### DIRECTIONS TO JOHNSON HAGOOD STADIUM SEE MAP 1

#### From Columbia

Take I-26 East to 17 South, turn right on Hagood Avenue (between Taco Bell/KFC and McDonald's).

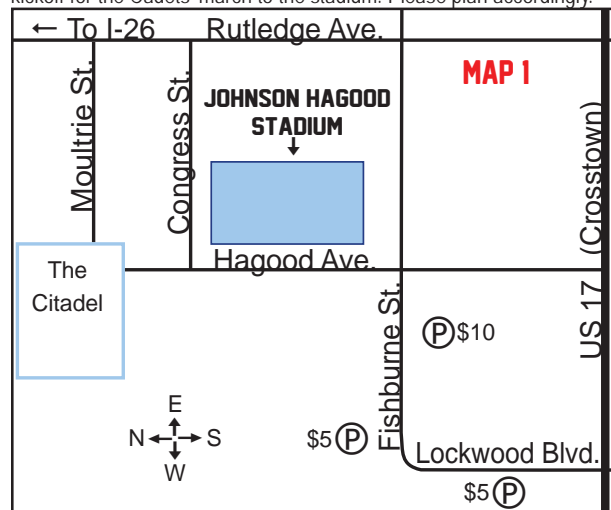
#### From Savannah

Take US-17 North, take the Lockwood Blvd Exit. At the light, turn left onto Lockwood Blvd. Continue straight and you will turn right on Fishburne Street to parking lots.

#### From Myrtle Beach

Take US-17 South, turn right on Hagood Avenue (between Taco Bell/KFC and McDonald's).

Hagood Avenue closes to traffic at least one hour before kickoff between Congress and Fishburne streets. Additionally, Hagood Avenue closes between the Citadel's campus and Congress Street half an hour before kickoff for the Cadets' march to the stadium. Please plan accordingly.



### PREGAME ACTIVITIES

#### Dress Parades

The South Carolina Corps of Cadets conducts a Military Dress Parade most Friday afternoons during the Fall. For times consult the parade schedule on the school's website: [www.Citadel.edu](http://www.Citadel.edu). Prior to Homecoming and Parents Day games, the Corps conducts Saturday Dress Parades at 11 a.m. on Summerall Field. Family and fans of The Citadel are also invited to tour The Citadel's barracks between 8:30 a.m. and 10 a.m. on both Saturdays.

#### Cadet March On

Join the South Carolina Corps of Cadets before each home game as they enter Sansom Field at Johnson Hagood Stadium to start pregame festivities. The Corps of Cadets marches onto the field 20 minutes before kickoff.

#### Touchdown Cannons

After each Bulldog score, cadets fire the Touchdown Cannons. The Cannons also lead the cadet march-over to Johnson Hagood Stadium.

#### The Citadel Sports Network

Follow the Bulldogs on The Citadel Sports Network's flagship station, ESPN Radio 910AM The Team. Tune in two hours before kickoff to catch

### PARKING SEE MAP 1

There is adequate parking within a few minutes' walk from Johnson Hagood Stadium. We urge everyone to join The Citadel Brigadier Foundation which has parking available based on level of contributions. Public parking is located down Fishburne Street near the Police Station for a \$10 fee. Additional parking is available at Riley Park and Brittlebank Park for \$5.

We respectfully request that everyone obey local traffic ordinances and that you do not block any residential driveways. You can also be a public relations agent for The Citadel.

#### Hours

Parking lots open four hours before regular home games. On Parents Day and Homecoming, lots open at 7 a.m.

#### Tailgating Policy

Tailgating is permitted for all cars in the parking lot areas, yet must not interfere with adjacent parking spaces or thoroughfares. We ask that everyone be considerate of your neighbors and keep all alcoholic beverages in the parking area. **Alcohol consumption must end two hours after the conclusion of the game. Alcohol is not permitted in the Riley Park or Brittlebank Park lots.**

### DISABLED SERVICES

#### Handicapped Parking

Limited handicapped parking is available adjacent to the West stands at \$10 per car on a first-come, first-served basis. Additional handicapped spots are located in the MUSC/C Lot on Fishburne Street.

#### Handicapped Shuttle

Shuttle service is provided from the handicapped parking area on Fishburne Street to Johnson Hagood Stadium. The shuttles consist of two eight-passenger golf carts and a wheelchair accessible bus. Service to the stadium begins 90 minutes before kickoff until 10 minutes after kickoff. Return service begins with five minutes left in the 4th quarter until 30 minutes after the end of the game.

#### Wheelchair Seating

Wheelchair seating is available on both the East and West stands in reserved and general admission sections. Please let the ticket office staff know that you require wheelchair accessible seating when placing your ticket order.

### FACILITY INFORMATION SEE MAP 2 ON OPPOSITE SIDE

Gameday should be an enjoyable experience for all fans and safety a primary concern. We encourage everyone to display a high degree of sportsmanship at all times. Spectators are not allowed, at any time, on the playing field or sidelines until after The Citadel Alma Mater is played at the conclusion of the game.

The gates to Johnson Hagood Stadium open 90 minutes prior to kickoff. Once inside the stadium, fans are permitted to move to either side of the stadium through the South End Zone walkway in front of the Altman Athletic Center.

#### Altman Center

The Altman Athletic Center, located in the south endzone, opens 90 minutes before kickoff. In order to access the Altman Center, guests must have an Altman Center pass and a valid game ticket.

### Announcements

Announcements will be made for emergencies only. If an emergency occurs, please contact your nearest stadium official. To request a personal message (birthday, anniversary, etc.) on the videoboard, contact the Sports Promotions & Marketing Office at (843) 953-6300. Charges will apply.

#### ATM

An ATM, provided by Carolina First Bank, is located on the West Concourse of Johnson Hagood Stadium.

#### Baby Changing Stations

Baby changing stations are located in men's and women's restrooms in the West Concourse of Johnson Hagood Stadium and in the women's room in the East Concourse.

#### Cameras

Video and still cameras are allowed. Pictures must be taken from the patron's seat and may not block aisles and walkways. Field access is limited to credentialed photographers only. Photos taken on The Citadel's campus and Johnson Hagood Stadium may not be sold or reproduced for commercial purposes unless approved by The Citadel's licensing agent.

#### First Aid Stations

Two first aid stations manned by paramedics are available to guests. They are located on the Southwest Terrace atop the West Stands and in the Northeast corner of the stadium near the flag pole for the East Stands. In case of an emergency, please notify your nearest stadium official.

#### Game Programs

Game programs are available for \$5 from vendors just inside the ticket gates and in the stands during the game. They are also available at the program booth underneath Sections A and M in the West Concourse and underneath Section Q in the East Concourse.

#### Guest Services

The Guest Services Table, presented by Bulldog Tours is located on the West Concourse below section G. It serves as the gameday lost and found, and is also where fans can claim prizes won during in-game promotions and contests.

#### Lost & Found

Items lost or found inside of the stadium may be identified at the Guest Services Table on gamedays or at McAlister Field House during the week. The Citadel's Public Safety Office also operates a campus lost and found. They are located next to Capers Hall at Lesesne Gate and can be reached by phone at (843)953-5114.

#### Prohibited Items

- umbrellas
- banners
- pets
- noisemakers
- irritants
- alcoholic beverages
- coolers
- cans
- bottles
- outside food
- weapons
- flags
- any items deemed dangerous by the game management staff.

Prohibited items may not be carried into nor used in Johnson Hagood Stadium. Check-in facilities are not available.

#### Recycling

The Citadel encourages everyone to think green and recycle in the stadium and at your tailgate. Recycling containers, provided by Coca-Cola can be found throughout the stadium and next to the dumpsters in the parking lots.

**Solicitation Policy**

Solicitation or distribution of materials by persons not preapproved by The Citadel Athletics Marketing Office is prohibited. Banners, flyers, pamphlets or any other paraphernalia will be disposed of by game day security and solicitors will be escorted off the premises. The selling of any item by anyone other than The Citadel authorized personnel, including in parking lots, is prohibited.

**Souvenirs**

The Citadel Gift Shop operates two souvenir stands in the stadium on gamedays. The stands are located centrally on each concourse. These stands do not open until 90 minutes before kickoff.

**Tobacco Use**

Johnson Hagood Stadium is a smoke and tobacco-free facility. Tobacco use, in any form, is not allowed in the stadium in seating areas, enclosed areas or either concourse.

**CLUB AND SUITES**

**Alcohol**

TCBF is solely responsible for the sale and service of alcoholic beverages within the Club and Suite areas of Johnson Hagood Stadium. All individuals purchasing and/or consuming alcoholic beverages must be at least 21 years of age per South Carolina state law and must be wearing an ID wristband at all times. **No one may bring alcohol into Johnson Hagood Stadium on gamedays.**

**Club/Suites**

Suite and club seat pass holders may enter the stadium through the "press/club/suite" entrance in the center of the West stands starting two hours before kickoff.

The Citadel's Athletic Ticket Office is located in McAlister Field House on the back, right-hand corner of the campus. Tickets for all athletic events are available there. Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover orders can be made in person or by calling the Ticket Office at (843) 953-DOGS. Office hours are 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Tickets to all games, both home and away, may also be purchased online at [www.etix.com](http://www.etix.com).

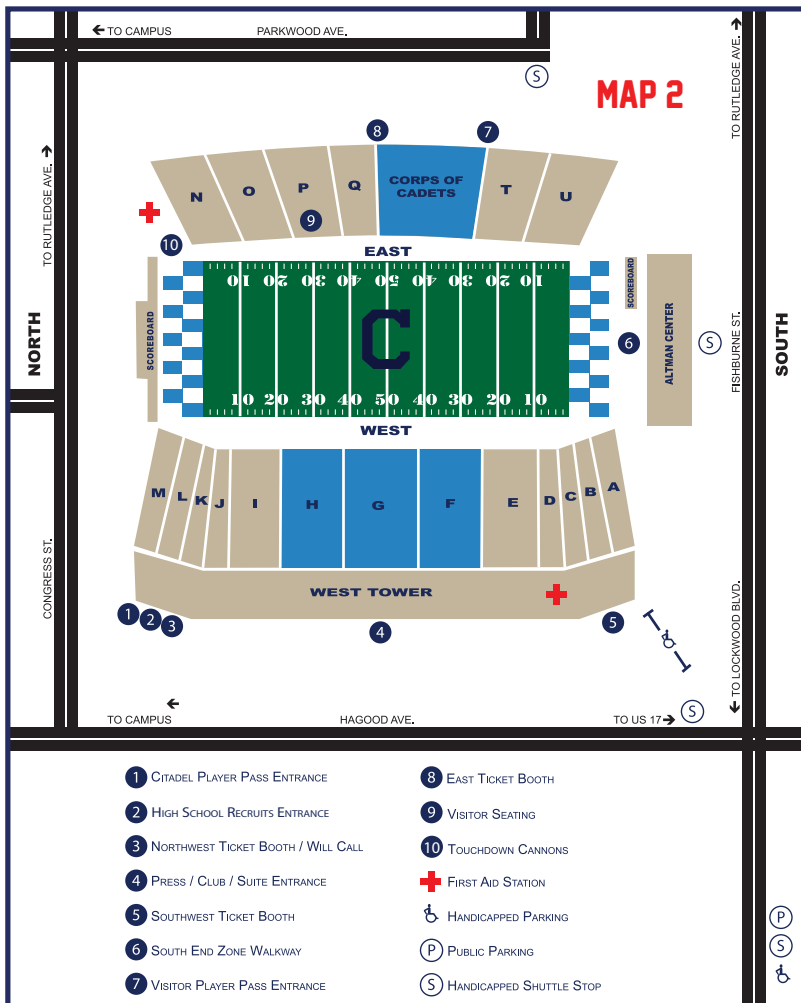
The Johnson Hagood Stadium ticket booths open at 9 a.m. on the morning of home games. On gameday, tickets may be purchased only with cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover.

**Player Passes**

Tickets left by players may be picked up at the player pass gates 90 minutes before kickoff. The visiting player pass gate is located on the East stands adjacent to the South light pole. The home player pass gate is located on the West stands at Gate 9. **Per NCAA regulations, all persons receiving complimentary admission must present a photo ID.**

**Recruits & High School Coaches**

Recruits and high school coaches must arrange for their complimentary tickets in advance by calling the football office at (843) 953-5123 by noon on Friday before each game. Recruits may enter through Gate 8 starting



two hours before kickoff. High school coaches can pick up their tickets at the East Ticket Booth starting 90 minutes before kickoff. **Per NCAA regulations, all persons receiving complimentary admission must present a photo ID.**

**Lost Tickets**

The Citadel is not responsible for lost, stolen or destroyed tickets and refunds will not be issued. Reprinted tickets will be issued to take the place of originals, upon verification of seating location. Tickets will be reprinted for the ticket holder of record only. Replacement tickets will have precedence over the original tickets.

**Will Call**

The will call window is located at the Northwest ticket booth on the West side of Johnson Hagood Stadium. Persons picking up tickets at Will Call must show a photo ID.

**Re-Entry**

Patrons may leave and re-enter Johnson Hagood Stadium. However, you must retain your ticket in order to re-enter the stadium.
